Lesson Focus: Digestive System Practice
Date: Late November/Early December
Time Needed: 50 Min.
Benchmarks/Common Core: SC.5.L.14.1 Identify the organs in the human body and describe their functions, including the skin, brain, heart, lungs, stomach, liver, intestines, pancreas, muscles and skeleton, reproductive organs, kidneys, bladder, and sensory organs.
Objective(s)/Essential Question: To understand the organs, function, and location of the digestive system.
Materials/Resources: Quizizz review game- https://quizizz.com/admin/quiz/581cbe7734a51cc227adb956 Wizer presentation- https://app.wizer.me/learn/A2YTAS assigned in Google Classroom Google Chromebooks
Introduction/Warm-up: Review with the students the organs, function, and location of the digestive system. The students will of had practice with this system during the week. Next, we will play the Quizizz digestive system game for practice.
Procedure/Activities: After the review, students will access their Google Classroom accounts and open the Wizer Digestive System Worksheet. They are to complete their Wizer worksheet for an assessment.

Lesson Conclusion/Summary: The students complete the Wizer worksheet. The takeaway from this lesson is the students will understand how the digestive system works, why it is important for humans to have a healthy digestive system, and what organs of the body are a part of the digestive system.
